- Academic update: State has decided that RISE scores are valid and will be used. We had a drop in some categories. Below state average in third, fourth, and fifth grade language arts. This is very atypical. Above state standards in math. Lower scores than in SAGE. School Land community council will make goals to address the problems.
- Board reviewed Utah Grants application. All deadlines have been met. No questions on School Improvement Plan, a document used to guide education of children. No need to approve application.
