- Allison Clinger joined at this point. Director's report:
 - COVID update: Discussed remote learning; enrollment fluctuations; teacher, parent, and student burnout; engagement issue for remote learners; technology restrictions.
 - Academic update: MTSS team has identified our students at risk of academic failure based upon NWEA assessment, DIBELS assessment, online programs (IXL, iReady, Lexia, etc), and teacher observations. Interventions have been put in place for 10 of those students in ELA. Will increase that number of students when school resumes after week of remote learning. Will work on math interventions in January.
